Call for Abstracts

On behalf of the Mayo School of Continuous Professional Development, and the Translational Review of Mood Disorders and Addiction 2015 course planning committee, you are invited to submit abstracts on your psychiatry/psychology practice, education or research initiatives for presentation at our opening day course poster reception on Thursday, October 29, 2015, 5:30-6:30 p.m. Posters should relate to preclinical and clinical new research in mood and addiction and may include guidelines, randomized trials, outcome studies, practice innovations, or descriptive analyses.

Scholarships will be awarded to graduate students, medical students, postdoctoral fellows, and physicians-in-training whose abstracts are accepted for presentation. The scholarship consists of a reduced registration fee of \$375 for the chosen presenters. All abstract submitters will also be considered for the top three Best Abstract Award(s). Each winner will receive a plaque which will be presented to the winner on Friday, October 30, 2015, before noon. First place receipient receives \$750; second place receives \$500; and third place receives \$250. Please note that poster award checks are made payable to the presenter or presenter's institution (based on the presenter's request).

Submission Deadline: August 31, 2015

Eligibility:

- Posters that either have or have not been presented at other meetings will be considered.
- Posters that have been published or based on full papers that have been published are eligible.
- Participants may be primary author on no more than two abstracts.
- Posters must be in English.
- Presenters must attend the poster reception.

- Notification of receipt will be emailed to the contact author within 2 business days of abstract receipt.
- Notification of abstract acceptance status will be emailed to the primary author listed on the abstract form after September 7, 2015.
