Dear Exhibitor,

On behalf of course director, Eric R. Eggenberger, D.O., we hope you will consider a display opportunity at our *Mayo Clinic Practical Clinical Case-Oriented Neuro-Ophthalmology course being held on November 15-17, 2018 at The Loews Royal Pacific Resort in Orlando, Florida.* We expect around 100 physicians who deal with neuro-ophthalmologic patients especially neurologists, ophthalmologists, optometrists, and neurosurgeons, but also other interested practitioners including internists, family care practitioners, emergency room physicians, and PAs.

This course reviews multiple topics in clinical neuro-ophthalmology. The first day consists of didactic lectures by experts in neuro-ophthalmology on various topics including papilledema, seuodapapilledma, diplopia, nystagmus and neuroradiology. On the second day, cases of common neuro-ophthalmologic problems are presented to our panel for discussion of practical approaches to patient evaluation and management. Conditions presented include optic neuritis, neuroretinitis, neuromyelitis optica, ischemic optic neuropathy, Horner syndrome, downbeat nystagmus and myasthenia gravis. The day also includes a session on the clinical and neuro-radiologic correlation of several neuro-ophthalmologic disease processes. The third day starts with case presentations by retina experts attempting to sort out the question of "optic nerve or retina?" as a cause of visual loss.

Display fees are \$2,000 for the length of this course. Space is limited and table assignments will be made on a first come, first served basis. Mayo Clinic, an integrated, not-for-profit group practice, is committed to meeting its responsibility as a national medical education resource and is accredited by the Accreditation Council for Continuing Medical Education to provide 16.25 AMA PRA Category 1 Credit(s) TM for this course.
