### Basic Cardiac Arrhythmias

- Normal conduction system of the heart
- Supraventricular arrhythmias
- AV blocks and bundle branch blocks
- Ventricular arrhythmias
- Initial treatment for arrhythmias.

### 12 Lead ECG Interpretation

- Systematically analyze normal and abnormal 12 lead ECG findings
- Recognize ECG patterns consistent with ischemia, injury and infarction on 12 lead ECGs
- Identify myocardial infarction with affected coronary artery distribution
- Identify selected intraventricular conduction defects
- Identify ECG characteristics consistent with atrial and ventricular hypertrophies
- Utilize 12 lead ECG to differentiate ventricular tachycardia vs. supraventricular tachycardia with aberrant conduction
