On behalf of Mayo Clinic and Mayo School of Continuous Professional Development we are pleased to announce our 20 th Annual Mayo Clinic Internal Medicine Update course will be held at the Hilton Sedona Resort at Bell Rock in Sedona, Arizona. Purpose of Form

An individual or entity (Form W-9 requester) who is required to file an information Affinitividual of entity (Forth w-s requester) who is required to the affinition return with the IRS must obtain your correct taxpayer identification number (TIN) which may be your social security number (SSN), individual taxpayer identification number (ITIN), adoption taxpayer identification number (ATIN), or employer identification number (EIN), to report on an information return the amount paid to you, or other amount reportable on an information return. • Form 1099-A (acquisition or abandonment of secured property)

Use Form W-9 only if you are a U.S. person (including a resident alien), to provide your correct TIN.

If you do not return Form W-9 to the requester with a TIN, you might be subject to backup withholding. See What is backup withholding? on page 2.

By signing the filled-out form, you:
