

STROKE “INNOVATIVE AND HEALTH CARE DELIVERY IDEAS “

Overview: This forum will be a rapid-paced event where attendees submit ideas to be reviewed by the Innovative and Health Care Delivery Ideas panelists. Panelists include stroke content experts, as well as industry, tech and start-up companies. Ideas submitted must impact stroke care either by one or more of the following methods:

- 1.) Practice-changing technology (smartphone app, device, sensors, artificial intelligence, or other technology) that ultimate enhances the value of stroke care (ie., reduced costs, improved quality, improved efficiency, communication, safety etc)
- 2.) Health Care Delivery re-design: these may include ‘health systems engineering’ ideas such as six-sigma product efficiency or LEAN models, improvements in stroke patient care by reducing health care costs using telemedicine or other technology. One example is the portable CT on an ambulance to provide more rapid stroke diagnosis prior to ED arrival. Another example is a weight scale as the patient rolls into the Emergency Room to weigh the patient for accurate weight for TPA administration.

Presentation Format: 5minute mini-presentations about ideas following by 5min Q&A by the panel. Accepted ideas will be offered venues for product or idea development.

Submission Acceptance process: Submitted ideas/proposals are kept confidential and reviewed by Mayo Clinic Directors of the Mayo Clinic Stroke and Cerebrovascular Review for quality. Exceptionally good ideas for improving or innovative stroke care from a health care delivery, business model, or mobile health or other innovative idea are ranked and graded. Accepted proposals are emailed notification to the submitting party by email.

Number of Entries: A maximum of two such proposals per meeting are allowed per person (first author) submitting. More than two are allowed from a team as long as not first author.

Deadline: Abstract submission deadline is **Monday August 3rd 2015**

Timeline: 1 month deliverable, 3months, and 1 year.
