COURSE DESCRIPTION

Up to date and practical information on the diagnosis, treatment and prevention of the infectious diseases you see most in your practice!

The field of infectious diseases is rapidly evolving with new diseases, diagnostic modalities, antimicrobial resistance and new paradigms for treatment. This new course combines the essentials of Coccidioidomycosis with an update on how to manage infections encountered in the outpatient setting.
