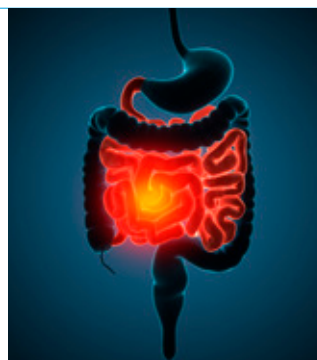
## INTENDED AUDIENCE

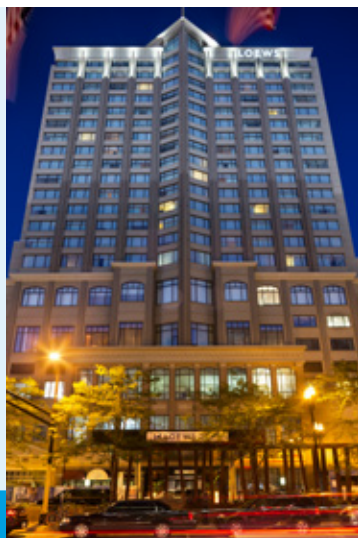
