The Mayo Clinic Hepato-Pancreatico-Biliary Cancer Symposium 2019 welcomes posters for display throughout the conference from Friday, November 15 – Saturday, November 16, 2019, to be presented during the Welcome Reception on Friday, November 15th from 5:00 – 6:30 p.m.

Nationally and internationally renowned faculty will provide a state-of-the-art update on the latest treatment options for patients with Hepato-Pancreatico-Biliary (HPB) cancers. The program is designed to provide a multi-disciplinary overview on the importance of early diagnosis and treatment considerations, including surgery, radiation, loco regional approaches, and systematic therapies. There will be an emphasis on implementation of these approaches into clinical practice.

Topics for the poster should be based on the various themes for the conference including:

- The importance of early diagnosis and treatment considerations, including surgery, radiation, loco regional approaches, and systematic therapies
- Implementation of the above approaches into clinical practice
- Precision medicine approaches in HPB cancers
- Immunotherapies in HPB cancers
- Multidisciplinary management of HPB Cancer Patient
- Novel preventative and diagnostic approaches in patient at risk for or with HPB cancers
- Scientific advances with translational potential and eventual clinical application as it relates to HPB cancers

The course directors welcome posters that address other related topics.

PRINTED POSTER SPECIFICATIONS

Posters at the Mayo Clinic Hepato-Pancreatico-Biliary Cancer Symposium 2019 will be displayed on double-sided display boards that are 48”x96” (4’ tall x 8’ wide). Pushpins and double-sided tape will be made available for mounting your poster.

Your poster(s) will be on display during the entire conference which will take place on Friday, November 15 – Saturday, November 16, 2019. Please setup your poster(s) between 7:00 – 8:00 am on Friday, November 15.

Your printed poster should be 48” high x 48” wide (4’x4’).

WHAT A POSTER SHOULD INCLUDE

You are free to design your poster to best showcase your work, through images, graphs, text, infographics or photos. It is recommended that the following information be included to fully outline your presentation to the audience:

- Title: project title
- Authors: your name, names of collaborators, and organization
- Background (or Introduction)

- Research Question or Purpose
- Methods or Interventions
- Results (or Results and Applications)
- Summary/Conclusions or Future Directions
- Acknowledgments: include any sources of funding your project received

CE credit will not be awarded for viewing posters. We encourage you, however, to disclose any financial relationships of the authors with commercial interests on your poster. This is not a requirement.

Individuals with approved poster presentations will be eligible for merit award scholarships, which cover the cost of course registration. **Presenters must be available to discuss posters on Friday, November 15th from 5:00 – 6:30 p.m.**

Your submission should be an abstract or short description of your program/topic. You are not required to submit the actual poster. Please send your submission to chauncey.tamara@mayo.edu by **September 30, 2019**. Submissions made after this date will be considered on a space available basis.
