

Convalescent Plasma COVID-19 Livestream

e-poster/e-case Presentation FAQ

- Q: Do you have to be affiliated with Mayo Clinic to submit a poster abstract?
- A: No, you do not need to be affiliated with Mayo Clinic to submit a poster abstract.
- Q: Do you have to register for Convalescent Plasma COVID-19 Livestream to *submit* a poster abstract?
- A: Yes, you do need be registered in order to submit a poster abstract.
- Q: Do you have to register to *present* the poster?
- A: Yes, if your poster is accepted, you are required to register for the course.
- Q: Do poster presenters get any expenses paid for by the course?
- A: Mayo Clinic is unable to pay for your conference expenses.
- Q: How are e-posters and e-cases selected for presentation?
- A: To have your e-poster or e-case considered for inclusion in the session, you will need to complete and submit the abstract form on the website describing the key points that will be displayed. Abstract submissions will be reviewed by the Planning Committee.
- Q: How many posters are selected for the poster presentation?
- A: 4 e-case posters and 4 e-poster presentations will be accepted; first-come-first-serve on a rolling basis
- Q: Can an e-poster or e-case be presented if it has already been presented/published elsewhere?
- A: Presenting in our session does not prohibit publishing the same information elsewhere (either before or after our session). However, to be selected, the e-poster or e-case needs to meet the criteria for our audience. If your work is being considered for publication elsewhere, please be sure that their rules do not prohibit you from presenting during the session.
- Q: Are there any other requirements?
- A: The only other requirements are those laid out in the submission instructions.
- Q: Who will view the e-poster and e-case sessions?
- A: Sessions will be viewed by registered attendees during the livestream.
