What is neurocognitive testing and why use it?

- Neurocognitive testing is the “cornerstone” of modern concussion management. It gives healthcare providers **objective data to evaluate a patient’s post-injury condition** and aids in tracking recovery for safe return to activity.
- It is **recommended that all patients should have a clinical neurological assessment** (including evaluation of mental status/ cognition, oculomotor function, gross sensorimotor, coordination, gait, vestibular function and balance) as part of their overall concussion management.

Why is ImPACT the right choice?

- ImPACT has two primary uses: before the onset of an activity, a **baseline test** is conducted to **measure the baseline performance**. In the event of an injury, a **post-injury test** is administered and **compared to the baseline scores and/or normative data**.
