## What is Guardant Reveal?

Guardant Reveal is a blood test that can help you answer:

- 1 Is there any cancer remaining in my body after surgery?
- 2 As part of my regular follow up, has my cancer returned?

This blood test determines if there is minimal residual disease (MRD), a small number of cancer cells that may remain in your body after treatment. The presence of MRD indicates a higher risk for cancer recurrence and may be a tool to help you and your doctor make more informed treatment decisions. Guardant Reveal doesn't require an invasive tissue sample and must be ordered by a physician.

## How often do I need to get tested?

### Post-Surgery

- 3 blood draws starting 4 weeks after surgery. Your provider will work with you on the timing of your blood tests.

### Follow-up monitoring



From a planned series of simple blood draws, Guardant Reveal can be used to monitor signs of cancer returning as time progresses.

## How is the Guardant Reveal test performed?



Simple blood draw



Test analyzed in a Guardant Health lab



You and your doctor will receive results in under 2 weeks

## What do my test results mean?

To identify if there is MRD, Guardant Reveal looks for circulating tumor DNA (ctDNA) in your blood. The test result will indicate if this ctDNA has been found in your blood and may help your provider identify if there are additional tests needed to confirm if the cancer remains or has relapsed.

### A POSITIVE TEST



indicates that there is a higher chance that cancer is present

### A NEGATIVE TEST



indicates that there is no residual cancer detected
