

### COVID-19

### LEARN

Mayo Clinic physicians and scientists were able to learn from the experience of other hospitals and adopt the best practices learned into our treatment paradigms.

#### TEAM

COVID-19 patients treated at Mayo Clinic were diagnosed, monitored and treated with a team- based approach that was designed to ensure that all patients were treated with the most up-to-date, evidence-based, treatments available.

#### **EXPERTS**

By including subject matter experts from a range of disciplines in our treatment teams, and having those treatment teams reviewing the care and progress of each patient daily, our outcomes were better than what had previously been reported

#### **OUTCOMES**

Patients with COVID-19 who received care at Mayo Clinic whether in the hospital or at home, had outcomes that compared favorably to those reported nationally and internationally.

### **COVID-19 Outcomes**

What COVID-19 treatment looked like at Mayo Clinic when the model of care was really put to the test.

- Just over 77.5% of hospitalized patients received at least one COVID-19 therapy, such as an antiviral drug, systemic steroid, immunomodulatory monoclonal antibody or convalescent plasma. Nearly one-quarter of hospitalized patients received two therapies, most commonly a combination of steroids and antiviral medications.
- An overall mortality rate of 1.1% was reported for patients treated at Mayo, with inpatient mortality of 7.1% and ICU mortality of 11.9%.
