- CASE #1 LANGNER 68-year-old male. Right-sided hemicolectomy with tumor mass at the right flexure
- CASE #2 LANGNER 65-year-old male. Bowel cancer screening case. Pedunculated polyp removed from the descending colon
- CASE #3 SHEPHERD 61-year-old female. Bowel cancer screening case. Positive FIT. 20 mm sigmoid colonic polyp at colonoscopy. Polyp had a firm base
- CASE #4 SHEPHERD 27-year-old female. Obstructing polypoid lesion of the ileum
- CASE #5 PAI 52-year-old male undergoing screening colonoscopy. Multiple small polyps found and removed
- CASE #6 SLAVIK 77-year-old female who presented with partial small intestinal obstruction. Resection of ileocecum and appendix performed
- CASE #7 BROWN Duodenal biopsy in a 38-year-old male. Past history of IBD colitis (no previous biopsies seen at our laboratory)
- CASE #8 SLAVIK 8-year-old immunocompromised boy (RVD+) with two-year history of abdominal distension, diarrhea, failure to thrive and night sweats, duodenal biopsies taken
- CASE #9 BROWN 59-year-old male. Epigastric pain. White plaque in antrum biopsied
- CASE #10 KUMARASINGHE 74-year-old male, presented with diarrhoea. At colonoscopy minor mucosal inflammation characterised by erythema,

granularity with loss of vascularity; no ulceration. Biopsies taken from ileum, right colon and left colon, sections from the right colon

CASE #11 SHEPHERD 58-year-old male. Rectal bleeding. MSM. Ulcerated tongue of tissue in lower rectum at sigmoidoscopy. Rectal biopsies

CASE #12 PAI 38-year-old female who undergoes an ileocecal resection for stricturing Crohn's disease

CASE #13 KUSHIMA 45-year-old female. ESD specimen of a reddish polyp found in the body of an *H. pylori* uninfected (naive) stomach

CASE #14 KUSHIMA 50-year-old female. Biopsy specimens in the first year after eradication of *H. pylori*. One from the greater curvature of the antrum and the other from the greater curvature of the gastric body

CASE #15 CARNEIRO Young adult, with family history of gastric cancer. The macroscopic appearance was unremarkable

CASE #16 CARNEIRO Young adult, with family history of gastric cancer. The macroscopic appearance was unremarkable

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CASE #18 LANGNER Oesophageal biopsies from a 40-year-old female with dysphagia

CASE #19 KUSHIMA 65 year-old-male. ESD specimen of the esophagus with squamous dysplasia noted on biopsy

CASE #20 KUSHIMA 70-year-old female with a well-defined polyp in the esophagus with surrounding iodine-solution unstained flat area. Biopsies from the polyp and the flat area
