Dr. Albright is a consultant in the Division of Nephrology and Hypertension with a specific clinical and research interest in critical care nephrology, dialysis, and chronic kidney disease. He is boarded in Internal Medicine, Nephrology, and Critical Care Medicine. He is a Professor of Medicine and holds a joint appointment in Pulmonary and Critical Care Medicine. His clinical career encompasses all aspects of Nephrology and Hypertension practice, specifically with expertise in ICU Nephrology but also in the

dialysis units. He had served as overall medical director of Mayo Clinic Dialysis Services from 2004 until 2014 and remains medical director of the Northfield Dialysis unit.

He has a long-term interest in health care systems' dynamics, has practiced extensively in the Mayo Clinic Health system, is a silver fellow in Quality Academy, and is a Fellow of the American Society of Nephrology.
