### Kevin Kling

Kevin Kling is a playwright, storyteller and author from Minneapolis, Minnesota. Born with TARS syndrome, resulting in a shortened left arm with no radius or thumb, he then lost the use of his right arm in a motorcycle accident in 2001.

Kevin's tells his unique tale – having a congenital disability and one “achieved” later in life -- using humor, myth and story. He has presented perspectives on trauma and loss to a variety of audiences, including healthcare professionals, hospice workers, first responders and disability advocates across the country. He was a well-known “All Things Considered” commentator and his disability story was told in the Emmy award-winning PBS documentary “Kevin Kling: Lost & Found”.
