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Kate Glogowski serves as Workforce Simulation Center Director at Minnesota State University, Mankato, where she leads workforce-focused simulation initiatives through the Maverick Family Nursing Simulation Center. She collaborates with Mayo Clinic Health System and regional partners to design, implement, and evaluate simulation-based education that supports clinical readiness, interprofessional development, and rural healthcare workforce capacity.

As MSU–MCHS Research Council Co-Chair, Kate has helped build partnership infrastructure that includes collaborative seed grant processes, education and research councils, interdisciplinary workgroups, and shared tools that connect academic and clinical experts around workforce priorities. Her work has supported funded initiatives in critical care, emergency medicine, obstetrics, trauma-informed care, procedural skills, AI readiness, and health informatics, creating a scalable model for translating clinical workforce needs into university-based educational solutions. This workshop draws on those experiences to share practical strategies other academic and healthcare partners can adapt to build sustainable workforce development collaborations.
