Dr. Young J. Juhn, MD, MPH, is a board-certified pediatrician and clinical informatician and a Professor of Pediatrics at Mayo Clinic College of Medicine. He serves as Research Chair of the Mayo Clinic Health System, Co-Director of the Mayo Clinic Center for Clinical and Translational Science, and Director of the Precision Population Science Lab. His research focuses on asthma epidemiology, computational phenotyping using artificial intelligence, digital biomarkers, and the influence of socioeconomic environment (SEE) on health outcomes, including development of the HOUSES Platform technology, the first and only exiting technology enabling a nationwide individual-level measure of socioeconomic status featured in the World Economic Forum.
