Dr. Syed Anjum Khan is the Director of Critical Care at Mayo Clinic Health System (MCHS) in Mankato. She earned her medical degree from Government Medical College Kashmir, completed her residency in Internal Medicine at the University of Hawaii, and completed a fellowship in Critical Care Medicine at Mayo Clinic in Rochester in 2005. Her clinical practice focuses on multispecialty critical care, with subspecialty certification in Neurocritical Care. Dr. Khan holds the academic rank of Professor of Medicine at the Mayo Clinic College of Medicine and Science. She is a Fellow of the Royal College of Physicians (London), a Fellow of Critical Care Medicine, and a Mayo Clinic Quality Fellow (Gold Level). She has authored more than 100 peer-reviewed publications and has edited three books.

Throughout her career, Dr. Khan has received numerous honors, including the Mayo Clinic Health System Clinical Excellence Award, Researcher of the Year Award, and the Emergency Medicine APP Fellowship Educator of the Year Award. She serves as the MCHS Minnesota Chair for Education and is co-chair of the Education Council, a collaborative partnership between Mayo Clinic Health System Mankato and Minnesota State University, Mankato.
