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Dr. Lynch is a primary care pediatrician at Mayo Clinic. In addition to providing pediatric outpatient care, Dr. Lynch holds numerous leadership positions at Mayo Clinic including being Medical Director of the Rochester area Primary Care Autism, Behavioral, and Developmental Screening Program since 2010, The Pediatric Primary Care Obesity Taskforce since 2012, Community Pediatric and Adolescent Medicine Vice Chair for Research (2017)- current, Olmsted County Physician Community Engagement leader since 2022, and various leadership positions in Mayo Clinic Health System Research since 2022 including Vice Chair for Research since 2025. Dr. Lynch was the American Academy of Pediatrics Minnesota Community Access to Child Health Facilitator 2009-2026. Dr. Lynch has focused his research career on how social determinants of health impact chronic health outcomes in children. He has led numerous community-based interventions for childhood obesity and for children who have experienced adverse childhood experiences. He has been the MSU-MCHS Research Council Co-Chair since 2026 and utilized his experience in leading collaborative health improvement projects with community partners and educating the workforce of the future.
