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Dr. Wi is an Associate Professor of Pediatrics at Mayo Clinic. He earned his M.D. from the Catholic University of Korea, School of Medicine in 2007 and joined Mayo Clinic in 2012. He serves as Associate Director of the Precision Population Science Lab and the HOUSES Program, Scientific Director of the AI Program in Pediatrics, and Co-Director of the AI Validation and Stewardship Program for the Mayo Clinic Health System. Dr. Wi has been co-leading an innovative mobile health unit outreach pilot in rural southern Minnesota. Recently, his team received funding from the Community Health: Assessment and Improvement Measures (CHAMP) Program to expand this initiative.
