PLANNING NOTES & OPEN DECISIONS

Carried over from Dr. Pasternak's Year-2 planning notes — to confirm at the next working session.

ITEMS REQUIRING SIGN-OFF

- **Confirmed:** Course Directors Malik & Pasternak; Feb 6–7, 2027 (Sat–Sun); Mayo Clinic Arizona IERB. Hold the room and confirm room capacity/breakout rooms for three concurrent tracks.
- **PCH contact & co-branding:** name the PCH designated contact; secure written consent for PCH logo/co-branding and the brand-standard review path.
- **Recording:** decide livestream/recording (Y/N); requires both parties' written consent.
- **Sponsorship & budget:** Skomer leads; refresh Year-1 prospectus; confirm a Night-1 reception sponsor; Mayo continues to assume all financial gain/loss.
- **Accreditation:** confirm activity runs under the existing collaboration agreement (addendum vs. re-sign) and that ACCME / ACPE / ANCC credit continues; lock MCSCPD's backward-planned deadlines.
- **Faculty & TBDs:** fill surgery-track speakers and PAC/parent-panel leads; coordinate content to avoid topic overlap flagged in 2026 evals.
